

WINTER INTERNATIONAL 2017 – JUDGES' RESUMES'



Ms. Yoko Koda (Japan)

Ms. Koda Has been involved in breeding Toy Poodles since 1970, and produced many champions. She has also been involved in breeding Shibas, Standard Poodles, Pomeranians, Shih Tzu, Yorkshire Terriers, Chihuahuas, Maltese, Dachshunds, Miniature Schnauzers, Siberian Huskies, Shetland Sheepdogs and Golden Retrievers.

Ms. Koda was first approved to judge Poodles in 1986, and approved as an All Breeds Judge in 2009. She has been judging at many shows throughout Japan including the FCI International Dog Shows. She has also judged in Taiwan.



Mr. Chua Ming Kok (Singapore)

Mr. Chua Ming Kok has been an active breed exhibitor since the early 1990s. He had campaigned many German Shepherd Dogs, Corgis, Samoyeds and Shetland Sheepdogs, Irish Setter, English Springer Spaniel, Golden Retrievers, English Bulldogs, Papillion, Wire Fox Terriers and Toy Poodles to their Championship Title. His Toy Poodle was Top Dog in 2010 and represented Singapore in Eukanuba World Challenge and came up as one of the 12 finalist out of 41 countries. He handled in Westminster in 2011 and won the breed at the Garden. He also handled and won the Breeders class at World Dog show in Paris 2011.

Mr Chua Ming Kok was approved as an FCI All Breeds Judges in 2016.



Ms. Keiko Kawada (Japan)

Ms. Kawada started in Yorkshire Terriers in 1970 and has been involved in breeding Yorkshire Terriers and Toy Poodles since that time.

She was Approved as an All Breeds Judge in 1987 and has been judging at many dog shows throughout Japan including the FCI International Dog Shows. She has also judged at shows in Mexico, Australia, Canada, Korea, Taiwan, Philippines and China.

Ms. Kawada's interest in grooming/trimming saw her study under Mr. Masahiro Ikeda in 1976, and qualified as JKC Approved Trimmer in Master Grade in 1989. She was appointed as JKC Trimmers' Examination Committee Member in 1997, and has judged at many trimming competitions throughout Japan and overseas at grooming competitions in Taiwan, Korea and China.



Mr. Chien-Wei (Jamy) Tang (Taiwan)

After having a Dobermann Pincher in 1974, he started breeding and showing and won his first BOB in 1975. He championed many Spitz Dogs, such as Shiba, Alita, Siberian Husky and Toy Dogs from 1997 with Maltese. He has also been highly successful with his Dachshunds (Long and Wire Coated and Bulldogs from 2008.

Mr. Chien-Wei Tang's judging career saw him gain his FCI All Breed status in 2014. He has judged at many shows, including FCI CACIB Shows in Taiwan and the Philippines.



Mr. Steven Gladstone USA)

Mr. Gladstone has bred and shown Cardigan Welsh Corgis under the Aragorn prefix since 1974. He was particularly successful with blue merle lines, but has bred dogs of most Cardigan colours. Mr. Gladstone has also owned Norwegian Elkhounds, German Shepherd Dogs, and Australian Shepherds. Mr. Gladstone began judging match shows in the late 1970s and was approved to judge Cardigans in 1988. He has since added the Utility, Working and Hound Groups. Judging trips have included assignments in New Zealand, England, Canada, and Saint Petersburg, Russia.



Ms. Carol Graham (Canada)

Mrs. Graham started her career in dogs with the purchase of a Miniature Poodle in 1964, which she showed and bred. In 1968 she moved into the breed of Schipperkes with great success. Carol also owned a couple of multi BIS winning Keeshonds in the 70's. She spent around 25 years as a Professional Handler, travelling all around North America, handling many different breeds to success. After retiring from handling in 1996 she has continued to breed and show Standard Poodles and Pomeranians. Commencing a judging career in 1997, Ms. Graham is now an All Breeds Judge, and has judged extensively in Canada and the USA, plus overseas in Japan.



Mrs. Ainslie Mills (Canada)

Ainslie and her husband Barrie have owned and loved Golden Retrievers since 1974. She has been active in Conformation, Obedience and Rally, with occasional ventures into Tracking and Field training. She has been extensively involved with Golden Retriever Clubs in Canada and has presented seminars on Golden Retrievers in Canada, the USA, Australia, Indonesia and Japan. I have judged conformation since 1992 and I am approved by the Canadian Kennel Club to judge all breeds. I have enjoyed judging all-breed and specialty shows from coast to coast across Canada and the USA, as well as in Indonesia, with multiple trips to Australia and New Zealand. I have judged the Golden Retriever National Specialties in the USA, Canada, Indonesia and Australia, the Canadian Nova Scotia Duck Tolling Retriever Club National Specialty plus numerous other Sporting, Herding and Working breed specialties.



Mr. Daniel Ceres Rubio (Brazil)

Mr. Rubio was born in Uruguay and has lived in Brazil, working as an Architect since 1978. At this time, he founded the "Performance Kennel", specialising in English Cocker Spaniels, which he is still involved with today. He has also bred and exhibited Boxers, Dachshunds and Bernese Mountain Dogs. Mr. Rubio gained his FCI All Breeds status in 2007 and has judged in Argentina, Chile, Colombia, Mexico and Venezuela as well as throughout Brazil. He has also been involved with Canine administration in Brazil.



Mr. Jose Doval Sanchez (Spain)

When he was 20 years old, Jose spent the summer working as swimming coach and with the money earned, bought his first Golden Retriever. Since then he has bred mainly Golden and Labrador Retrievers, under the affix "De la Enna", Brussels Griffons, Miniature Wirehaired Dachshunds and Spanish Water Dogs in the last few years.

As an International FCI Judge, he has judged All Breed Shows and Club shows in Spain, Portugal, France, Italy, Croatia, Austria, Germany, Holland, Poland, Latvia, Estonia, Czech Republic, Russia, Finland, Norway, Sweden, Slovenia, Scotland, England, Northern Ireland, Ireland, Hungary, Israel, Belgium, South Africa and Australia.
